Veteran – Civilian Dialogue Developed in 2008, the Veteran – Civilian Dialogue™ (VCD) is a powerful form of community building and social healing focused on addressing the cost of conflict in our society, and providing meaningful tools for reconciliation and healing. VCD is a live event with equal numbers of veterans and civilians in facilitated conversations around the impact of war upon both groups. They have proven to be life-altering for those who attend, and healing for the larger elements of the communities that are brought together through the process.

Intersections is a non-governmental organization that works with communities in conflict to promote peace, justice and reconciliation. We create experiences that allow diverse people to share in unexpected moments that shift perceptions and bend the arc of history.

WHY SUCH LOSS:

For those in the military, death is woven into a profession where suicide is one of the side effects.
